GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR E-POSTER SUBMISSION JAKARTA PERIOPERATIVE MEETING 2026

The E-Poster competition is open to:

- Medical students
- General practitioners
- Nurses
- Other healthcare professionals
- Residents (Sp1) and fellows (Sp2) in Anesthesiology and Intensive Care

Each E-Poster may include multiple authors; however, only one author will serve as the presenter. The presenter's name must be written in italic and underlined.

E-Poster Categories: Case Report and Research

Technical Requirements

1. Submitted abstracts and E-Posters must be original and must not have been previously presented or published in any scientific meeting or other media.
2. Eligible topics include:
 - Perioperative management
 - Anesthesia
 - Intensive care
 - Pain management
3. Abstracts and E-Posters must be written in Bahasa Indonesia.
4. The E-Poster must be designed in landscape orientation with a resolution of 1920 × 1080 pixels (16:9 widescreen format) and arranged in three columns.)
5. Abstracts must be submitted in .doc or .docx format, with a maximum of 300 words (excluding title and references). A maximum of 7 references may be included, using the Vancouver referencing style.
6. Authors' names and institutional affiliations must be clearly stated. The first author listed must be the presenting author, and their name must be written in italic and underlined.
7. The E-Poster may include text, tables, figures, images, photographs, and other relevant visual materials related to the selected topic.

8. The design of the E-Poster should maintain a balanced and professional composition between text and visual elements (tables, figures, and images).
9. The E-Poster file must be submitted in .pdf and .ppt format.
10. The font types permitted are Tahoma, Arial, or Calibri, with a font size of 20 pt for the title and 14 pt for the main content.
11. The E-Poster content must be aligned with its respective category (Case Report or Research) and follow the provided guidelines.
12. All submitted abstracts and E-Posters will become the property of the Jakarta Perioperative Meeting (JPM) 2024 Organizing Committee.

Registration Procedure

- Participants must prepare the E-Poster and abstract in accordance with the established guidelines.
- Participants are required to complete the registration form and submit their E-Poster via the following link: <https://bit.ly/EPOSTERJPM2026>
- The deadline for submission of both the E-Poster and abstract is June 1, 2026. Submissions received after this date will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

E-Poster Judging Process

- All submitted E-Posters will undergo an initial review by the Panel of Judges.
- E-Poster presentations will be held on July 26, 2024, starting at 13:00.
- Each participant will be allocated 11 minutes, consisting of:
 - 7 minutes for presentation
 - 4 minutes for discussion and Q&A
- The decision of the Panel of Judges is final and binding.
